### Discussion Items:

1. The committee welcomed three new members:
  - a. Marcel Papineau has 12 years of experience, mostly residential, currently with Intelligent Design Engineers in Charlotte
  - b. Prentice Tyndall owns a 14-year old firm in Garner, outside Raleigh, doing 70% residential and 30% commercial projects
  - c. Wayne Hoose is a structural steel welding inspector with 30 years of experience and owner of UTL, Inc. in Raleigh; interest in the Special Inspections initiative
2. Residential construction: the committee previously identified a shortage of SEA members with residential expertise, a concern given much of the Building Code Council activity concerns the Residential Code
  - a. PT is a member of the North Carolina Homebuilders Association; he will join the Building Code Committee of the HBA and serve as a liaison for the SEA of NC
  - b. MP will advise the committee on residential related committee activity
3. Special Inspections:
  - a. RE is connecting with the Special Inspections / Quality Assurance subcommittee of the NCSEA Code Advisory Committee
  - b. WH volunteered to facilitate a special inspections forum, sharing experience from the field
4. SK provided a NC Building Code Council update
  - a. The cross laminated timber proposal passed and will be incorporated in the residential and commercial codes

- b. The 2018 building code re-write effort is starting
  - i. Jeff Morrison of Stroud Pence in Raleigh is representing the SEA of NC on the structural committee
5. PT suggested that Woodworks be asked to provide training seminars statewide
6. EBP proposed developing a schedule for coverage of the Building Code Council quarterly meetings, with two attendees per meeting on a rotating schedule
