## Structural Engineering Emergency Response (SEER) Committee

### Volunteer Inspector Requirements

In addition to the California EMA Safety Assessment Program (ATC-20 and ATC-45 training), there are two FEMA classes that are required to be a Volunteer Inspector. These FEMA classes can be taken on-line, free of charge through an independent study program offered by the Emergency Management Institute (EMI). The required classes are:

1. IS-100.b Introduction to Incident Command System

As an introduction to the Incident Command System (ICS), this course provides the foundation for higher level ICS training. This course describes the history, features and principles, and organizational structure of the Incident Command System. It also explains the relationship between ICS and the National Incident Management System (NIMS).

2. IS-200.b ICS for Single Resource and Initial Action Incidents

This course is designed to enable personnel to operate efficiently during an incident or event within the Incident Command System (ICS). ICS-200 provides training on and resources for personnel who are likely to assume a supervisory position within the ICS.

By clicking the link to the selected class you are taken to a site containing the course overview, a link to the interactive web based course, a link to the classroom materials, and a link to the final exam. To take the final exam you must have a FEMA Student Identification (SID) number. Go to [www.cdp.dhs.gov/femasid](http://www.cdp.dhs.gov/femasid) to obtain this ID number.

Upon completion of the final exam you will click submit at which time it will be scored by EMI who will send you your score via email within one business day. A score of 75% or higher is required to pass the test and receive a link to access your certificate of completion.

These certificates of completion shall be maintained by the individual and furnished to the SEA, ASCE or AIA when requested.
